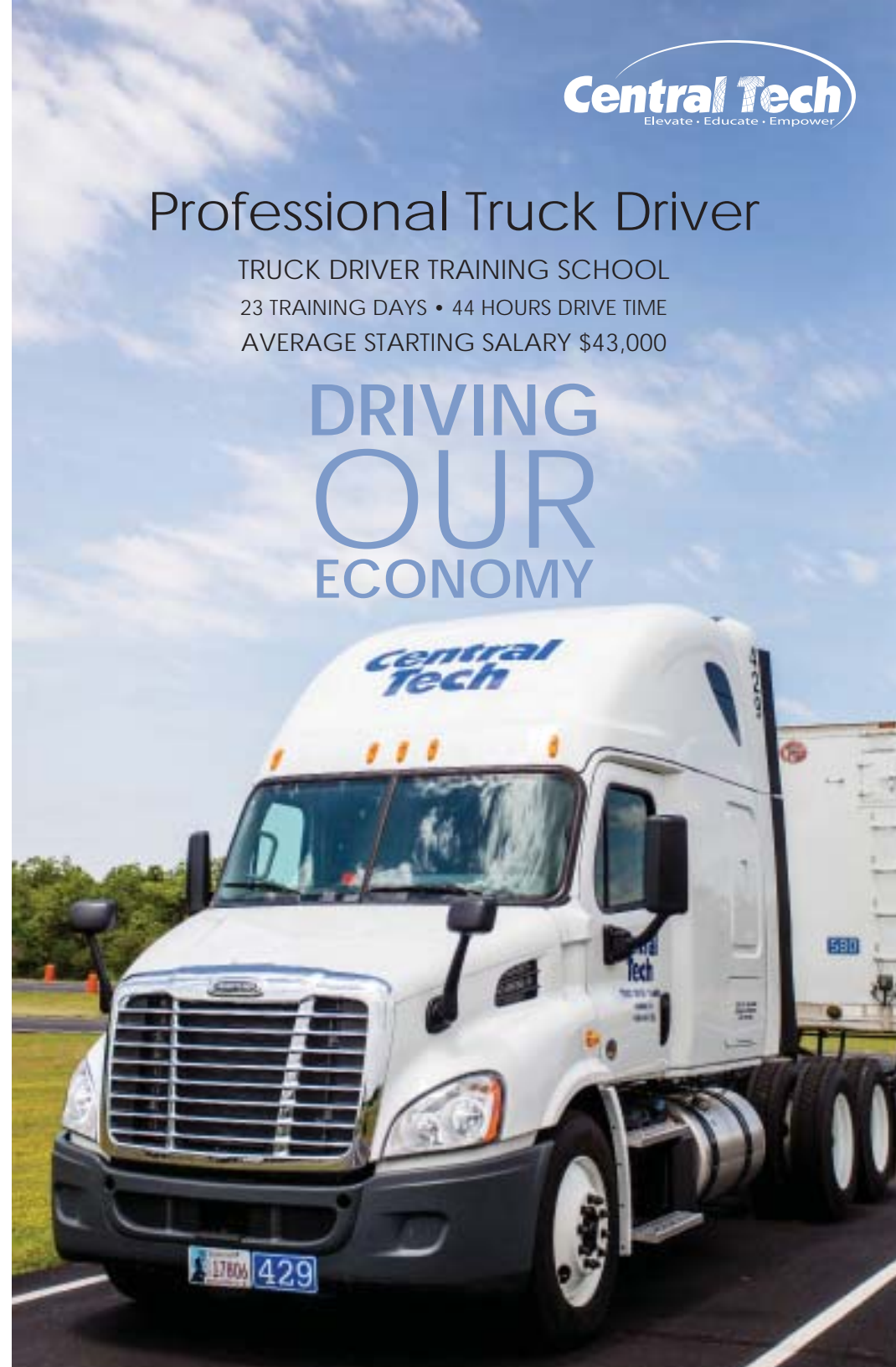

Upon successful completion of the class/exams and having met all requirements, students earn:

The state-of-the-art facility has a **driving range** with more than **three miles** of paved roadway on **45 acres**. The range is equipped with traffic signs, railroad crossing, and skill practice areas designed to allow each student to develop the skills necessary to become proficient in driving today's tractor trailers.

Two students per truck allows each student a minimum of **44 hours of drive time** ensuring the ability to develop proficient driving skills including:

- 21-years-old or older
- Valid drivers license
- Safe driving record
- No drug or alcohol related offense within last five (5) years
- Meet minimum Department of Transportation physical requirements
- Citizen of the United States of America or legal resident alien
- Able to read, write, and speak the English language fluently enough to converse with the public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals, to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records
